

CURRICULUM DETAILS

During the course, the child will go through a transformative journey in a fun, engaging, and non-judgmental environment to master the skills required to be a great public speaker:

- Researching and presenting
- Understanding communication style
- Vocal elements of effective speech delivery
- Effective body language
- Persuasive speaking: The power of ethos, pathos and logos
- Art of story telling
- Active listening
- Knowing your audience
- Reaching consensus
- Evaluation and feedback

1. Ice-breaking session

he first session will involve group introduction, understanding the kids' expectations from the summer camp and an overview of the course structure. We also introducing various roles that kids will play in sessions 2-8 along with role allocation for each session.

2. Speakathon (Day 2-8)

The class will be divided into batches of 10 each assigned to mentor. The mentors are trained and accomplished speakers who will orchestrate the unique learning environment that promotes learning by active participation and continuous improvement. The class construct will be as follows:

- Prepared speeches (3): Kids will come prepared with a speech on topic based on day's theme
- Auxiliary role plays (4): Timer, Filler word counter, Table topic master, Joke master
- **Extempore speeches (5-6):** Almost every student will make extempore speech on one of the topics curated by the Table topic master of the day
- **Mentor evaluation:** Mentor will provide actionable feedback to speakers and auxiliary role players around the building blocks of speaking with impact
- **Diagnosis of World best speeches:** Team will discuss one of the many best world speeches in each class and diagnose the key elements that made it powerful.
- Group reflections: Group will close with reflections on the key learnings from the day

3. Group discussions (Day 9)

In this class, the students will learn about how to effectively orchestrate group discussions and reach a consensus within a group. The kids will be divided into groups of 10 each and will be given a topic for group discussion that will be moderated by the mentor

4. Mega public speaking event (Day 10)

Each student will close the course in a grand style where he/ she will make a final TEDtalk style speech in front of a braod audience. The event will be broadcasted live on Youtube.

PN: Throughout the course, mentors will be available to guide students on preparing for planned speeches and to provide personalized attention to each kid to help him/her improve on his/her areas of attention
